Shells

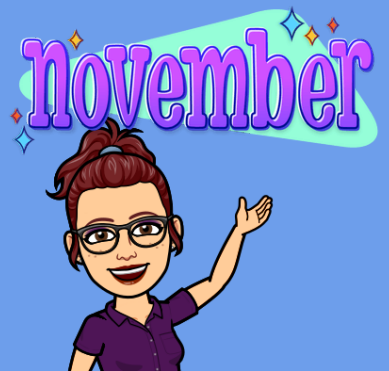
For Wednesday, 23rd October

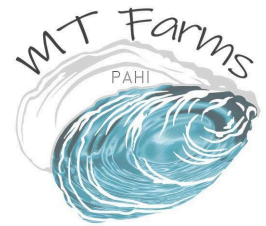
